

The Time is Always Now

From November 21st - 23rd Museumsbygningen will be hosting the fair 'The Time is Always Now', where eight different agents from the world of design, art, photography and books will take part. The fair is the second edition of 'The Time is Now,' which took place in Museumsbygningen last year and where the focal point was the cross field between art and design. 'The Time is Always Now' prolongs this concept.

This year the focus is primarily on the technical fabrication, which gives an object the aesthetic finish - whether it is a design object, an artwork, a photograph or a book.

A number of the participants at the fair use traditional techniques and working methods in their designs and thereby try to maintain the traditions of their craft.

All the participants work to enlarge the knowledge of art and design of high artisanal quality.

In this industrialized world where the production is often about quantity rather than quality, it seems relevant to focus on the handcrafted aspect of art and design.
